Section V, Scope of Service, Services to be provided by the vendor, Page 28. This section indicates that TBWA expects that the proposals should reflect the services and anticipated levels as described in this RFP.

Question #1: (answered on May 20, 2008) TBWA listed all components of the Scope of Work, are they open to change or are they set?

Answer: The deliverables listed in the Scope of Work are required elements of the RFP. The Responder can include additional components or recommendations that they would consider innovative in its proposal.

Question #2: (answered on May 28, 2008) In the RFP it states that the proposal must include a Cover Page. Does this mean just a cover page or can we include a cover letter as well?

Answer: The response should provide a cover page that: States the RFP number and title, contains Respondent's name, contact person, address, phone number, fax number, and email address as listed on Page 7 of the RFP.
